



INSTRUCTIONS for PRESENTERS of ORAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Dear presenters, due to the COVID-19 pandemic emergency, the URSI GASS 2021 will be held on-site, with provision for online participation and presentations. All the presenting authors, both in presence or online, will be given the possibility to present and discuss their work LIVE.

ONLINE PRESENTERS

Those planning to connect remotely online are required to upload the pre-recorded presentation file before **August 16th**, as back-up solution in case of any unforeseen issue with the internet connection. This eliminates the risk of “no show” due to a technical impediment.

ACCEPTED FORMAT for pre-recorded PRESENTATIONS:

- Microsoft PowerPoint with voice/video embedded.
- MP4 video file (as obtained, for example, with zoom recording).

For both formats, the maximum duration shall be 15 minutes to allow questions and answers during the remaining 5 minutes.

ONSITE PRESENTERS

ALL the presenting authors who are planning to join on-site in Rome, will be required to upload their slides presentation file in advance or, at the latest, when they arrive to the venue. IT WILL NOT be possible, for any reason, to use personal computers or to carry out last-minute uploads in the session room. All the rooms are equipped in such a way to guarantee onsite and online participation and the different devices cannot accept last minute uploads from USB keys or memory sticks. A Speaker Ready Room will be available, where presenters can check and upload their presentations.

ACCEPTED FORMAT for SLIDES:

- Microsoft PowerPoint
- Portable Document Format

ALL PRESENTERS

ALL the presenting authors will receive soon a link and credentials for uploading files. Files must be named through the code of your paper as it appears in the scientific program, followed by FirstName_LastName of the presenter. For example: Mo-G02-AM1-2_John_Wayne.
